Level 2 Skills Test

To move from Level 2 to Level 3, the dog must be able to:

(All exercises with normal classroom distractions unless otherwise noted.)

1. Sit-stay with handler while approached by a stranger; accept petting from stranger without jumping, mouthing, excessive shyness or aggression (CGC #1 and #2).
2. Sit-stay for 30 seconds at a distance of 6 ft. from handler.
3. Down-stay for 1 minute at a distance of 6 ft. from handler.
4. Sit-stay while handler walks around dog in a circle, both directions, radius < 3 ft.
5. Down-stay while handler walks around dog in a circle, both directions, radius < 3 ft.
6. Stay (either sit or down) while handler walks a distance of 20 feet and returns (CGC #6).
7. Stay (either sit or down) while the following 3 distractions are presented for 5 seconds each: bouncing ball, stuffed toy on string, dropped food.
8. Recall to handler 20 ft. away from each of the following 3 distractions: person holding food or toy, another dog, food on floor.
9. Walk on a loose leash up to another handler/dog team, sit-stay and ignore other handler/dog while handlers converse, walk past other dog (CGC #8).
10. Walk on a loose lead without sniffing or pulling over a course that includes a right turn, a left turn, an about turn, and two halts (CGC #4).
11. Heel 25 feet with attention on handler without a food lure, sit at halt (no distractions).
12. Heel 10 feet past food on the floor a distance of 3 feet away.

To move from Level 2 to Level 3, the handler must:

1. Demonstrate a behavior taught to dog on own at home without assistance from instructor.
